## BurJuman art and music fest starts

OVER 150 local and international artistes will perform at BurJuman's annual Art and Musical Festival from today till October 31. The 10-day event was introduced two years ago by BurJuman offering artistes an opportunity to showcase their innovative works and exceptional talent.

The exhibits will include all forms of paintings from around the world, sculptures, pottery, carving, Islamic calligraphy and handicrafts. The mall will also come alive to the melodic sounds of strolling players as they tour the mall dressed in period costumes.
